Eligibility: Students pursuing two- or four-year degrees in agronomy, crop production or closely related fields. Scholarship is available only to high school seniors, graduating in 2010, or college students in their first or second year of pursuing a two- or four-year degree.

- Applications must be signed by a school official and postmarked by February 1, 2010.
